

Loitering

Section I

No person or persons shall loiter on any public street, sidewalk, parking area or public park within the Town of Woodstock, in such a manner as to impede pedestrian traffic on said public street, sidewalk, parking area or public park, or in such a manner as to partially or completely obstruct free ingress or egress to or from the entrance of any business establishment, apartment building, or private dwelling adjacent to such public street, sidewalk, parking area or public park. This ordinance shall not apply to those engaging in constitutionally protected activities.

Section II

Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation, punishable by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for an initial offense and the fine shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each subsequent offense.
