# Use of Public Streets, Sidewalks, & Town-Owned Property/ Vendor Ordinance

#### Section I

- A. No person shall engage in the sale, rent, or display of merchandise, or the sale or serving of any type of food or drink, upon any public way, including the sidewalks, or from a vehicle parked on any public property or street in the Town of Woodstock without completing the Application for Permission to Use Public Streets & Sidewalks or Townowned Property and receiving the written consent of the Board of Selectmen. Consent is subject to the provisions outlined in Section II.
- B. No person shall attempt to sell merchandise or services of any kind door to door nor solicit subscriptions to or donations for magazines or any type of publication.

### Section II

### SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS:

- 1. The Town grants the Individual/Business permission to utilize public streets, sidewalks, or any other town-owned property
- 2. The Individual/Business shall be solely responsible for repairing all damage done to the Property due to the use thereof. Such repairs shall be undertaken only after the individual/business and the Town meet to discuss the proposed repairs and the Town approves those repairs. The Town shall also have the right to inspect the repairs and, if it finds them to be inadequate, to undertake further work at the Individual's/Business's expense to repair the property.
- 3. This permission may be revoked by the Town at any time and without any notice and shall be revoked upon the Individual's/Business's failure to meet their obligations under Paragraph 2.
- 4. During the term of this application and any extension thereof, the Individual/Business shall maintain, at their sole expense, General Liability, Automobile Liability, and Workers' Compensation insurance coverage with such limits as set forth by the Town. A certificate of Insurance will be required.

## Section III

Any person violating this ordinance shall be fined \$100 per offense.
