Joel called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Gil seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.

Public Participation:

Woodstock Cooperative:

Sherry Hoover, Donald LaFrance, and Shirley Torres members of the Woodstock Cooperative Board of Directors at White Birch Estates addressed the Board with concerns pertaining to the abandoned mobile home located at 18 Scenic View Drive owned by Ronald and Tammy Sicely. They explained that they served the Sicely's with an eviction notice and writ of possession on May 18th for back rent and found the condition of the mobile to be deplorable, uninhabitable, and feel it should be condemned. They questioned the process to demolish and asked the Board for forgiveness on back taxes.

The Board explained the typical process to remove or demolish a mobile home. They are unsure what authority they have in a situation like this but will contact legal counsel for advice.

This money is to be withdrawn from the Woodstock Firefighter Capital Reserve Fund. Gil seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.
