Jim called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Gil seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.

Public Participation:

Towing Rotation/Speed Bear & Wilson's:

Speed Bear and Wilson's questioned how the tow rotation is determined for the Woodstock Police Department. Chief Moorhead stated that the Woodstock Police Department does not have a tow rotation. Chief Moorhead informed both owners that Grafton County Dispatch determines the rotation. The Chief recommended that they contact the Sheriff's Department to be added to the rotation list.

Soldier's Park/Cascade Park/Bob Stahler:

Bob reviewed a layout for the granite pavers and bricks at Soldier's Park.

Bob suggested "no smoking signs" for Cascade Park.

Cox Farm Road/Robert McAfee:

Robert stated that he is looking for proof that the State of NH transferred Cox Farm Road to the Town of Woodstock. Robert informed the Board that the information provided to him on July 23, 2012 does not prove this. Robert noted that it does prove that Cox Farm Road is classified as Class 5 from the entrance off Eastside Road to the bend where the road heads south. Robert stated that the Town is responsible for maintaining that section of the road and pointed out that it needs a lot of work. Robert would like to see some proof of ownership. The Board informed Robert that they have provided him with a copy of everything the town office has pertaining to Cox Farm Road.

Skid Steer/Chipper/Playground Equipment/Bill Conn:

Bill stated that he has been hearing a lot of comments around town pertaining to his possession of the skid steer, chipper, and playground equipment. Bill explained how he acquired each item and asked the Board if they had any further questions. Joel informed Bill that he didn't have a problem with who had possession of the equipment as long as everyone is granted the same opportunities .

Minutes of the July 31, 2012 Meetings:

Joel motioned to accept the minutes of the July 31, 2012 Selectmen's Meeting. Gil seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.

Sign MS-1 Extension:

Gil motioned to file an MS-1 Extension Request. The Department of Revenue has informed the Board that the Utility Values will not be ready until mid to late September. Joel seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.

Emergency Apparatus Access/PD Shed & Garage:

Bill Mellett needed access to emergency apparatus being stored in the Police Department garage. Bill does not have a key and could not locate an Officer. Gil will meet with Doug to see if they can relocate the emergency apparatus to a place where all emergency response would have access to it.

Old Business:**Update/Steven Fongeallaz Property Status:**

Steven Fongeallaz signed for a certified letter, on August 7, 2012, that stated the conditions that would be required in order to repurchase his property. Steven will have until September 3, 2012 to meet these conditions.

Update/Bruce Rogers Property Status:

Bruce paid his 2009 Tax Lien in full on August 6, 2012.
